

LIMS Internships

Starting from spring 2024, the [LIMS – Interdepartmental Lab Memory and Society](#) will offer **two-month internships to advanced MA and PhD students** from Universities from **Italy and abroad**.

The internship can be carried on in the framework of the Erasmus Programme, if the foreign University is willing to do so.

The internships will be max 4 per year:

- 2 **spring** internships (April-May) - Application deadline: 30 December
- 2 **fall** internships (Oct.-Nov.) - Application deadline: 30 June

Venues: Department of Humanities (via Tommaso Gar 14) and Department of Sociology and Social Research (via Verdi 26), 38122 Trento, Italy.

Interns will be assigned to a tutor at the Department of Humanities or at the Department of Sociology and Social Research (usually, one each in each spring/fall session), but they will be expected to collaborate in any case with both Departments. An extension to three months might be arranged.

Activities will be multi-disciplinary (history and sociology mainly, but also anthropology, international politics, psychology, literature, and others) and multi-lingual (Italian and English). They include attendance of a memory-studies curricular course (30 hours), participation to LIMS scientific activities and projects (lunch seminars, guest lectures), collaboration to LIMS administration and promotion, plus other activities arranged with and supervised by the tutor and other colleagues, and the development of one's own research on memory.

Residence in Trento is required, although smart-working periods might be possible. Expected daily working hours are 8, Mon. to Fri.

Students will provide for their own accommodation and travel.

Applications must be submitted, along with a CV and a motivational letter (500 words max.), both in English, via the [online form](#)

Results will be communicated in a 2-week time.
